## Attitudes to Learning

We closely monitor your ATL and where it does not meet our required standard of 1.67 or better, we will discuss this with you as appropriate. In the first instance, this will be a support conversation with your Mentor, but could include a meeting with the Sixth Form Student Manager, Director of Sixth Form, and/or with parents/carers as part of our termly Mentor Review process. This is where you will sit down on a 1:1 basis with your Mentor and reflect on your development over the term. You will set clear SMART targets for development and will continually review these. In cases where we believe that your ATL has been affected by issues with time management, organisation, or quality of work, we reserve the right to ask you to remain in school during afternoons where you would usually be allowed to study from home (provided we have parental permission and there are no attendance concerns).

The following table, which was devised by Sixth Form students as part of our student voice process, provides an overview of ATL at Sixth Form and what is expected for an outstanding ATL of 1 in a subject:
