Endeavour Taekwondo

Dear parent/carer

During the next half term, we will be offering taekwondo classes during lunch times as an additional provision for students. These taekwondo classes will enable students to learn basic martial arts skills in the Korean sport.

The sessions will be offered to students **every Monday lunch time** during the spring and summer term. The sessions are being delivered through an external company called Endeavour Taekwondo. The provision will be priced at £4 per session, £44 in total for the sessions, which will need to be paid as a block in advance, of the sessions taking place from Monday 28th April to Monday 21st July 2025.

Due to health and safety and capacity, there are only 12 spaces available for each lunch time and spaces will therefore be offered on a first come first served basis. In order for us to assess the amount of interest in this provision, please can we ask that you complete the following form https://forms.office.com/e/p3BT6tLz0F to indicate your child's interest in taking part. Due to the limited number of places available please be aware that completion of this form does not secure your child a place. Further information, including how to make the £44 payment via Scopay, will be made available to those who are successful in due course therefore if you do not hear from us, please assume you have not been successful. Once the 12 available spaces have been filled, all other students who have expressed an interest will join the waiting list. Should any students drop out of the sessions, the space will be offered to another student on the waiting list. Please note the deadline for responses is Friday 28th March. Unfortunately, refunds will not be made for students who do not attend the provision or choose to drop out of the provision once the payment has been made.

If you require any financial support to enable your child to take part in these sessions please do let us know.

The classes will be led by Sarah Harney who is familiar with the school as a parent of children who attend Garibaldi and has also previously been a Governor. Sarah is a fourth-degree black belt, international instructor and referee. Endeavour Taekwondo boasts numerous world champions and both Sarah and her team have competed across Europe winning numerous medals and accolades. Sarah works closely with the British University Taekwondo League. Students have found a positive view from universities on applications as the sport is viewed as a course of continuous study outside of a standard curriculum.
